Recruitment Credit

All school families are eligible for a recruitment credit. Any current school family that recruits a new K - 6 school family is entitled to a \$100 tuition credit. Current families that recruit a preschool family are also eligible when that family begins kindergarten.

Haiti

A Diocesan Check from 52 parishes, 2 schools, and 7 individuals for \$304,351.58 was sent to Catholic Relief Services last Monday for Haiti Relief. One parish sent donation to Diocese but also \$2,375.92 to assist a priest in Haiti who has taken in 31 seminarians. Another parish sent Haiti a donation to Diocese but also \$7,675.00 to St. Vincent De Paul Society. Four parishes and six individuals sent \$10,348.70 directly to CRS. So a total of \$324,751.20 from our diocese has been sent to help people in Haiti. This total does not include individual CRS donations. Thank you all for your generosity.
